We've grouped the various pieces of data we may collect, use, store and transfer together –

Identity – includes title, first name and last name

Contact – includes billing address, email address and telephone number

Financial – includes payment card details

Transactional – includes payments between us and any products/services purchased from us

Technical – includes your IP, browser details, operating system, time zone and location

Usage – includes how you use our website and/or emails

Marketing – includes your preferences for receiving marketing materials from us

### **How we collect your data**

We use a number of methods to collect from and about you, such as –

Directly when -

You register a domain name

You subscribe to our newsletter

Automatically when –

You use our website and interact with our newsletter and other emails

You purchase a product or service and use our payment provider

### **How we use your data**

Comply with a legal obligation
